CONGREGATION B'NAI JESHURUN SAFETY PROTOCOLS

In order to be mindful of the health and well-being of all who join us in person for High Holidays services, we are instituting safety processes based on CDC guidelines and guidance from United Synagogue.

The entire building will be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized by an outside professional company prior to our reopening. Bathrooms will be cleaned and sanitized before and after each Service

Please note the following protocols:

- ✚ Tickets will be by reservations only for each individual
- ✚ An infectious disease screening form will be mailed to ticket holders to be completed and brought to services with them.
- ✚ Temperatures and tickets will be checked prior to entry
- ✚ Please arrive several minutes before the scheduled time to allow for check in
- ✚ No one can be allowed entry without a mask, including children over 2
- ✚ Everyone will need to bring and wear a mask at all times including when speaking.
- ✚ Avoid touching your face with your hands
- ✚ Hand sanitizer must be used upon entry. Hand sanitizing stations will be set up in the Sanctuary and Oneg Room. All other areas will be closed.
- ✚ Kippahs, head coverings and prayer shawls cannot be provided. Please bring your own.
- ✚ Please bring your own Lev Shalem mahzor - Information on how to purchase and dedicate is in Shabbat Shalom and mailings. There will be copies of parts of the Service for those who do not have a mahzor.
- ✚ Seat assignments are spaced out according to 6 feet distancing. No one in front or behind you. Unusable seats will be cordoned off
- ✚ For everyone's safety, please do not walk around during the Service
- ✚ Only the Rabbi, Cantor and Gabbai will be allowed on the Bima.
- ✚ Torahs will not be carried around the Sanctuary
- ✚ Readings and aliyot from assigned seats.
- ✚ There will be one way in and one way out with directional floor markers
- ✚ We regret that there can be no Walk-Ins and no one admitted without a reservation
